- 1.0 Call to Order: M. DeBace
- 2.0 Attendance: M. DeBace, L. Gilchrist, T. Lucas, W. Gaertner, R. Larson, C. Lehto, L. McClellan
- 3.0 Secretary Report: Approval of last meeting minutes: R. Larson motioned, W. Gaertner seconded
- 4.0 Treasurers Report: C. Lehto – Budget is on track. No concerns to report.
- 5.0 Coaches Report: No coaches in attendance
- 6.0 Old Business:
 - 6.1 Cub Foods Bagging – Event went well. Made about \$900
 - 6.2 Wing Stop – for Jan 11th. Includes gift cards and on-line orders. Tammy to send flyer out to players and families. Tom will put information on the webpage.
 - 6.3 Chipotle – The proceeds check was received (about \$650).
 - 6.4 Chuck a Puck – All slots are full. A request was made to have an adult to pick up the winning puck in the future instead of one of the children helping. That has been the procedure, but did not occur on one night. Will continue to remind volunteers of this in the future. T. Tuft donated his winnings back. Thank you!
 - 6.5 Carbo Loads – Spots are pretty much full. Could use volunteer for this Friday, but not a huge deal if no one steps forward.
 - 6.6 Youth Night – Afternoon game worked well. Suggestion to try to do it earlier in the season. Also helped that the girls game was followed by the boys game. May need more assistance the day of the game. Was a comment that the girls invited out onto the ice from the RAYHA teams were not from all levels (example: 10U A player invited but not 10U B). Need to coordinate it a bit better so that the B teams does not feel slighted. Also need to consider including the JV girls in youth night somehow, so that they also get some recognition. Will try to get a flag made for next year.
 - 6.7 Moms Night – We loved Mom's night! Please keep this tradition next year.
 - 6.8 Reading Raiders – D. Lehto will check in with Jill Ray
 - 6.9 Adopt-a-Team – This year it was too difficult with coordinating schedules to have specific girls adopt specific teams. For this year, was better to send different girls to practices. May need to talk to the RAYHA coaches about how to use the players when they do show up to a practice.
 - 6.10 OS Tournament Fundraiser: Volunteers went well. We are currently unsure of exact profit. In planning for next year, please have someone from the booster club connect with Winny late in the summer to come up with a plan.
 - 6.11 Sponsor Night: No sponsors attended the last sponsor night. Will need to consider if this is needed.
 - 6.12 Senior Night: Tuesday Jan 30th. Senior parents need to get questionnaires and photos to Tom ASAP. Seniors need to get Envelope and other info to Karen ASAP. Tom Lucas' printer

has donated the printing again this year for the senior night program. 5 senior players and 1 senior manager.

7.1 Senior Posters – Idea was brought up that it would be nice to have senior posters hung in the ice arena, similar to what parents have seen at other rinks.
