Fundraising:

1. **Roseville Community Fund** - Denise wrote out grant application, Renee presented it, they are meeting and will decide by this Thursday. This can be reapplied for quarterly if needed. This will help pay for new black jerseys which cost \$4400 includes socks
2. **Muscle milk grant** deadline has passed, and would need to be split with school
3. **Cub foods bagging** to be re- scheduled, was cancelled in August
4. **Chipotle** - Kay checking into
5. **Chuck a puck for hall of fame game:** we will sell pucks for \$2 each, 3 for \$5, 6 for \$10 etc. There are 140 or so numbered pucks, we want to sell 200 so will need to borrow more

Kay will email Janine info on businesses to contact for yearbook, and that info will be available onto our website. Artwork will be able to be added via the website and must be in by Oct 26. The yearbook goes to the printer Nov 13th and we receive them Nov 20th in time for our first home game. Each advertiser can get 2 tickets to a game either 11/30 and 12/9.
